HISTORY

- Oldest nudist resort in Florida
- Started as an orange grove and marmalade stand
- Organized before WWII
- Became an outdoor nude family health club after WWII
- Became a co-op in 1998
- 200 acres of nature and sports to enjoy

THE LAKES

- Beautiful 65 acre Big Moss Lake and Deer Lake
- White sandy beach on Big Moss Lake
- Swimming, boating and fishing
- Check out the paddle boats and kayaks from the office at no charge
- Sailing sessions available on request
- Yearly water ski shows – high-flying thrills by local professional show team with members from Cypress Gardens Adventure Park
- Catch some fish – we stock our lakes, fishing license required
- Lighted fountains and holiday water displays
- Beach pavilions, cement bonfire pit, firewood, grill and picnic areas
- Lakeside fitness equipment

HUGE SWIMMING POOL

- Live poolside entertainment on posted weekends and holidays
- Lighted at night – swim 24/7
- Order from poolside café and eat by the pool or bring your own food and beverages (no glass)
- Heated in cooler months
- Swim some laps or just play
- Showers are required each time you get into the pool to keep it sparkling clean
- “Float-In Movies” on movie screen with professional sound equipment, popcorn, plus drink and food specials in the café on movie nights – warm weather months as posted
- Be nude even when it’s freezing outside alongside pool next to café that provides wind protection. Heat from the sun bounces off windows and heats up cement under your chair to keep you warm
- Shaded area for hotter months
- “Noodles” provided or bring your own. Floating mats, pool toys OK
- Children must be accompanied by parent
- Heart of resort social scene

BEST NUDE RESORT HOT TUB

- Open 24/7
- “Birdcage” keeps bugs and debris out
- Hot showers right next to tub - required each time you enter
- Smoke-free, no food
- Beverages in non-glass containers allowed
- Very large tub with powerful jets and filters, constantly cleaned
- Great place to make new friends

- Close to pool, hotel and amenities

“CLUB COMO” RECREATION HALL

- Smoke-free dance every Saturday night, no minors
- Available for parties and meetings
- Full kitchen, dance floor, special effects sound and lighting

RELAX AND ENJOY THE AMENITIES

- Sauna – heats up in 20 minutes
- Billiards (Pool) Room – adults only, join a game or practice your shots
- Library – open 24 hours, self serve. Constant flow of new material with donations of books and magazines daily
- Wi-fi Internet connectivity in amenities area

- Original farm house during Lake Como’s early citrus grove days
- Open Sun. - Thurs. 8 am to 8 pm, Fri. & Sat. 8 am to 9 pm for breakfast, lunch and dinner plus appetizers, desserts
- Full bar and “comfort food” at very affordable prices
- Live entertainment and interactive games on posted evenings
- Wednesday night is “Buffet in the Buff” - discount to fully nude patrons
- Temperature is controlled to provide comfort to nude diners

WORLD FAMOUS “BUTT HUTT”

- Full bar, open 4 p.m. weekdays, 1 p.m. weekends and some holidays
- Sand floors – it’s a beach bar!
- Open air venue with air exchanger and fans – smoking permitted
- Karaoke three nights per week
- Live bands, entertainment for holidays, special events
- Order food from café for delivery to Butt Hutt
- Big screen TVs to watch and cheer for your favorite team
- Electronic dart games, tournaments

SPORTS COMPLEXES

- Five state of the art lighted professional clay (Har-tru) tennis courts, machine-groomed regularly – West Grove
- Lake Como Driving Range – practice your golf skills – West Grove
- Sand volleyball courts with room for more during tournaments
- “Super Bowl South” Volleyball Tournament every March
- Lakeside multipurpose lighted court for tennis or basketball with equipment available
- Lakeside petanque courts with daily competitions at 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. in snowbird season and whenever there is interest otherwise
- Lakeside horseshoe courts - games at 12 p.m. on weekends - equipment supplied

NATURE TRAILS

- Trails around the park, lakes and wildlife areas. Observe deer, osprey, bald eagles, wild turkeys, sand hill cranes, gopher tortoises, armadillo, bobcat and many other creatures as well as exotic and native plant species – pick citrus fruit and bananas when in season

ACTIVITIES/CLASSES

- Computer Club – learn how to use your computer better, upgrade or buy a new one, create products and fun projects, newest software and hardware explained - Mac and PC
- Nautical Nudist Dive Club – enjoy nude boating, snorkeling and other water sports

- Fenced Dog Walk with gazebo for shade, fresh water for thirsty canines
- Leashed pet area near RV storage area

RESIDENTIAL PARK

- 200 resident lots – some full time, some snow birds – all ages
- One mobile home park – the original resort area for mobile homes of all ages and the South Grove Village area for new mobile home owners with 33 new spaces
- Residents can rent their space or become shareholders
- School bus stops at end of Cot Rd.
- 200 acres to enjoy home, nature and sports

VISITOR'S LODGING

- 22 rooms
- Some with private bath, some share bath
- Smoking and non-smoking rooms available
- Choice of indoor and outdoor shower facilities
- Picnic areas and kitchen facilities close to rooms

CAMPING

- 39 RV spaces with full hookups
- New bath house with indoor laundry and restroom, outdoor shower
- Special area for tent and pop-up camping – we supply the firewood when available
- Propane and dump station
- Ice machine near office

RV STORAGE

- Secure fenced area, locked 24/7
- Affordable monthly storage - fees based on size

DRESS CODE

- We are not clothing-optional – please bare with us
- A towel to sit on is required in all areas
- No swimsuits, g-strings, thongs, t-backs or lingerie/underwear are allowed on the grounds
- Skin only in the pool, sauna and hot tub (no suits)

- We expect members and guests to be nude as much as possible, with exceptions for weather, health, safety and the very few times when common sense makes clothing necessary

WHO IS WELCOME AT LAKE COMO?

- Nudist and naturist families and singles
- Your good behavior is your passport at Lake Como - not your marital status, sexual orientation or who you know

BEHAVIOR

- We are a family resort – behavior is monitored so everyone can enjoy the resort
- Sexual or inappropriate behavior in front of others is not tolerated
- Management reserves the right to remove any person who breaks the rules or commits a crime on the property and to permanently ban individuals for serious offenses
- Security is paramount – Lake Como staff does background checks on all visitors and works closely with the Pasco County Sheriff's Dept. and all other law enforcement agencies.
